

## Pre-Nursing Program Plan

The goal during the pre-nursing years is to complete all nursing admission prerequisite requirements, in addition to all other degree requirements that are not built into the nursing program plan. This includes General Education Requirements, course work in science, social sciences, humanities, electives, and math. Following are generic sample schedules for the two pre-nursing years, your specific situation may (and likely will) look differently:

- All prerequisites should be completed on the UW–Madison campus unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- Priority enrollment is granted for pre-nursing (PRN) students for ANAT&PHY 337 (fall semesters only) and ANAT&PHY 335 (spring semesters only). Priority enrollment does not guarantee a seat in the course.
- The microbiology lab (MICRO 102) and the anatomy lab (ANAT&PHY 338) are optional for the UW–Madison nursing program but may be required for other nursing schools and potentially for licensure post-graduation within certain states.
