## **International Nurse Admission Requirements**

BSN@Home (RN-to-BSN) applicants who have earned an Associate's Degree in Nursing (ADN) (or equivalent degree) through an international institution are eligible for admission consideration to the nursing program. International applicants must be admissible to the University of Wisconsin–Madison and must also meet the minimum BSN@Home program eligibility criteria. The following notes apply:

## Admission to UW-Madison

- A student will be considered for admission to the UW–Madison as a transfer student.
- Foreign institutions must be recognized by the Ministry of Education in that country, per the UW–Madison <u>Transfer Credit Policy</u>.
- Admission to UW–Madison does not guarantee admission to the BSN@Home program.
- If a candidate for admission has specific questions about admission to the university, he/she should contact the UW–Madison Office of Admissions and Recruitment.

## **BSN@Home Program Eligibility**

Applicants who earn their ADN degree (or equivalent) from an international institution must also meet the following requirements to be eligible for admission consideration to the competitive/selective BSN@Home program. These candidates must:

- Hold an active Wisconsin Registered Nurse (RN) license
- Be a resident of the state of Wisconsin
- Demonstrate satisfactory completion of the following coursework:
