Prerequisite Course Evaluation

Please note that there are specific eligibility requirements for the prerequisite courses. Please make sure to take note of grade expectations, deadlines and timelines for all courses. Information can be found on our website: https://nursing.wisc.edu/undergraduate/bsn-accelerated/

- 1. Review our Nursing Prerequisite Equivalency Tables to see if course equivalents from your current/former institution(s) have already been established.
- 2. Check in Transferology whether transferable courses and equivalencies in the databases will satisfy nursing program prerequisites as stipulated.
- 3. If you are unable to determine if a course is equivalent, compare the UW-Madison course descriptions with the course you be lieve might serve as an equivalent. Consider course title and objectives, prerequisites, credit load, lab/lecture hours, textbooks, sequence, etc.
- 4. Complete the following table listing each course you would like evaluated. Use the italicized examples as a guide. You must provide a direct link to the course in the course catalog of the institution attended or submit your syllabus with the request.
